- A medical referral from your primary care physician (PCP) and/or the specialist who feels you need to see rheumatology
- Last visit notes from PCP and specialists-- you do need to be established with a PCP even if referred by a specialist
- Recent lab work including basic labs and any rheumatological labs that have already been completed
- Any pertinent imaging including reports and disks if we are unable to access them independently
- Any records from previous rheumatologists you may have seen-- this includes if you are seeking a second opinion
- Insurance referral (if needed by your plan)

We will need to have this information packet complete prior to making your appointment with one of our rheumatologists. It is your responsibility to make sure that we receive this information from your PCP and/or specialist in a timely manner so that we can move forward with your care.
